Tynan Coffee and Tea is breakfast and lunch stop and a place for local residents, commuters, stay-at-home moms and students to work, meet, or simply unwind.

Tynan offers four types of organic coffee grown in Peru, Columbia, Mexico, and Ethiopia.

Tynan Coffee & Tea opened its doors in Washington D.C.'s Columbia Heights neighborhood in October, 2009. Local brothers, Jim and Brian Sullivan aimed to offer a contemporary take on the neighborhood coffeehouse—an alternative to the “corporate” coffeehouse atmosphere—for professionals with busy agendas. They also are committed to being a responsible community citizen by having a positive economic and environmental impact whenever possible. To that end, and to make sure their coffee is uniquely “Washington” in taste, they have partnered with local suppliers.

In the Columbia Heights location, a mural on the wall depicts the eclectic history of the neighborhood, a feature that will be incorporated at each new location. An EcoSmart fireplace adds warmth and ambiance, is “flue-less” and requires no utility connection for fuel or venting. Powered by renewable Denatured Ethanol, the fireplace burns clean and is virtually maintenance free.

To meet the demands of the area’s increasingly health-conscious consumers, Tynan offers four types of organic coffee grown in Peru, Columbia, Mexico, and Ethiopia. All have been nominated as the Tynan Coffee of the Day. They also carry seven different kinds of green and black tea, and five herbals teas, two of which—Yerba Mate and Rooibos—are organic.

But that’s not all: Tynan Coffee and Tea is also a breakfast and lunch stop and a place for local residents, commuters, stay-at-home moms and students to work, meet, or simply unwind. They have free WIFI access for computer users.

In May, Tynan was the 2010 coffee and iced tea sponsor for Turtle Park’s May Fair, a fund raising event with all proceeds going to the Friendship Heights Recreation Center. In August, they plan to take part in the fourth annual Columbia Heights Day. On September 25, Tynan will be one of the restaurants participating in the Taste of Friendship Heights, a local fundraising event benefiting Chevy Chase’s Friendship Heights Center.
